During the 18th point of GA Agenda the delegates discussed on the election of the country which will have the honor to host the 15th IFToMM World Congress (IFToMM'19). Three Countries candidated to have this honor: Australia, Japan and Poland. The proposal of the Polish Committee for the Theory of Machines and Mechanisms (PC TMM) was as follows: organize the Congress in Cracow with one day trip to Zakopane – to remind the place of the First Congress on Theory of Machines and Mechanisms in 1969 the foundation of the IFToMM in it.

The Polish proposal has been adopted by 34 votes on 42 voting delegates. After election we received a lot of congratulations. Our succes is due to the involvement of the PCTMM members which always have well rated by the Executive Council and highly evaluated by the IFToMM General Assembly.

I would like to express special thanks to Prof. Tadeusz Uhl for your very interesting presentation of the Polish proposal.

Prof. Marco Ceccarelli has been elected president IFToMM on four – year term of office from 2016 until the General Assembly in Cracow - Zakopane in 2019. Congratulating him I invited Prof. Marco Ceccarelli to Poland on our Jubilee 25 Conference TMM in 2016.

On 29.10.2015, at a formal banquet, thanking delegates and participants for supporting our proposal for organizing the 15 World Congress in Poland I handed on to Prof. Shuo Hung Chang - General Chair of IFToMM'2015 World Congress, framed photocopies of the plaque installed on the occasion of the 40th Anniversary of establishing IFToMM in Zakopane. This plaque included the names of eighteen IFToMM Founding Fathers, and it allows_me to recall the memory_of the Academician Ivan Artobolevski - the first IFToMM President, Prof. Erskine Crossley – first vice – president IFToMM and his hundredth birthday celebrations in Taipei, of Jan Oderfeld and others. I would like to add that I was the unique delegate who participated at the Founding Congress in Zakopane in September 1969, and Prof. Ceccarelli presented me as a Founding Father of IFToMM.

And turning to the audience banquet participants I said:

On behalf of the Polish IFToMM Committee and myself, I cordially invite all Participants as well as all IFToMM COMMUNITIES to Poland_and more specifically to Cracow and Zakopane to celebrate the 50th anniversary of the founding of IFToMM in Zakopane in 1969.

The 14th IFToMM 2015 World Congress was successfully held in Taipei on October 25 for five days. Approximately 700 delegates from 45 countries/regions have participated and presented 522 papers. Four presentations have comprised overviews. Five volumes of research studies have been published. For example - one of the interesting lectures was the presentation by Prof. Hong - Sen Yan from National Cheng Kung University, Taiwan, delivered an interesting lecture on "Decoding the Lost and Incomplete Ancient Mechanisms and Machines". Based on historical archives, ancient mechanisms and machines Professor has presented surviving designs and historical documentation.

The Congress program included 78 technical sessions, one special session on the Life and Work of Erskine Crosley - the First Vice - President of IFToMM and several technical forums on the themes of industry 4.0, intelligent automation, intelligent machine tool, and micro-fabrication technologies. The 14th IFToMM 2015 World Congress was a great and successful event, and it can claim that it was a memorable visit for those who joined this event during their stay in Taipei.

Papers have been presented out in 21 sections. There were only 10 participants from the Poland who submitted 7 papers.
